






Eurydice National Unit in Ukraine – SSI "Institute of Educational Analytics"



The State Scientific Institution "Institute of Educational Analytics" (SSI "IEA") is a leading research organisation in Ukraine specialising in the development of educational statistics and information analytics. Its principal mission is to provide reliable information and analytical support to the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine (MESU) in shaping and implementing state policy in the fields of education and science. The SSI "IEA" serves as the information and analytical back office of the MESU, effectively employing modern IT tools and Data Science methods. It ensures the technical administration and maintenance of the national Education Management Information Systems (EMIS), which are continuously being expanded and upgraded through the introduction of new software applications.

An important aspect of the SSI "IEA" work is international cooperation, in particular the implementation of EU-funded projects aimed at harmonising Ukraine's education system with the European Education Area. On 15 June 2023, the MESU signed an Agreement with the European Commission on cooperation in the field of education, which opened up new opportunities for closer alignment with the European Union. Subsequently, in 2024, Ukraine officially joined the European education information network Eurydice, marking an important step towards further European integration in the sphere of education.

The SSI "IEA" has been designated as the National Eurydice Unit in Ukraine within the framework of the EU Erasmus+ programme. Alongside Ukraine, Moldova and Georgia have also joined the Eurydice Network, bringing the total number of National Units to 43 and the number of participating countries to 40.

The Eurydice Network aims to explain how education systems in Europe are organised and function. The Eurydice website regularly publishes and updates information on national education systems, thematic and comparative reports, statistical data in the field of education, as well as visual and reference materials.

The Eurydice platform provides comprehensive and reliable information on education systems in Europe, available for comparison, analysis and the development of evidence-based education policy.

National Eurydice Units are responsible, among other tasks, for compiling descriptions of their national education systems, structured in 13 main chapters according to a common European framework.
